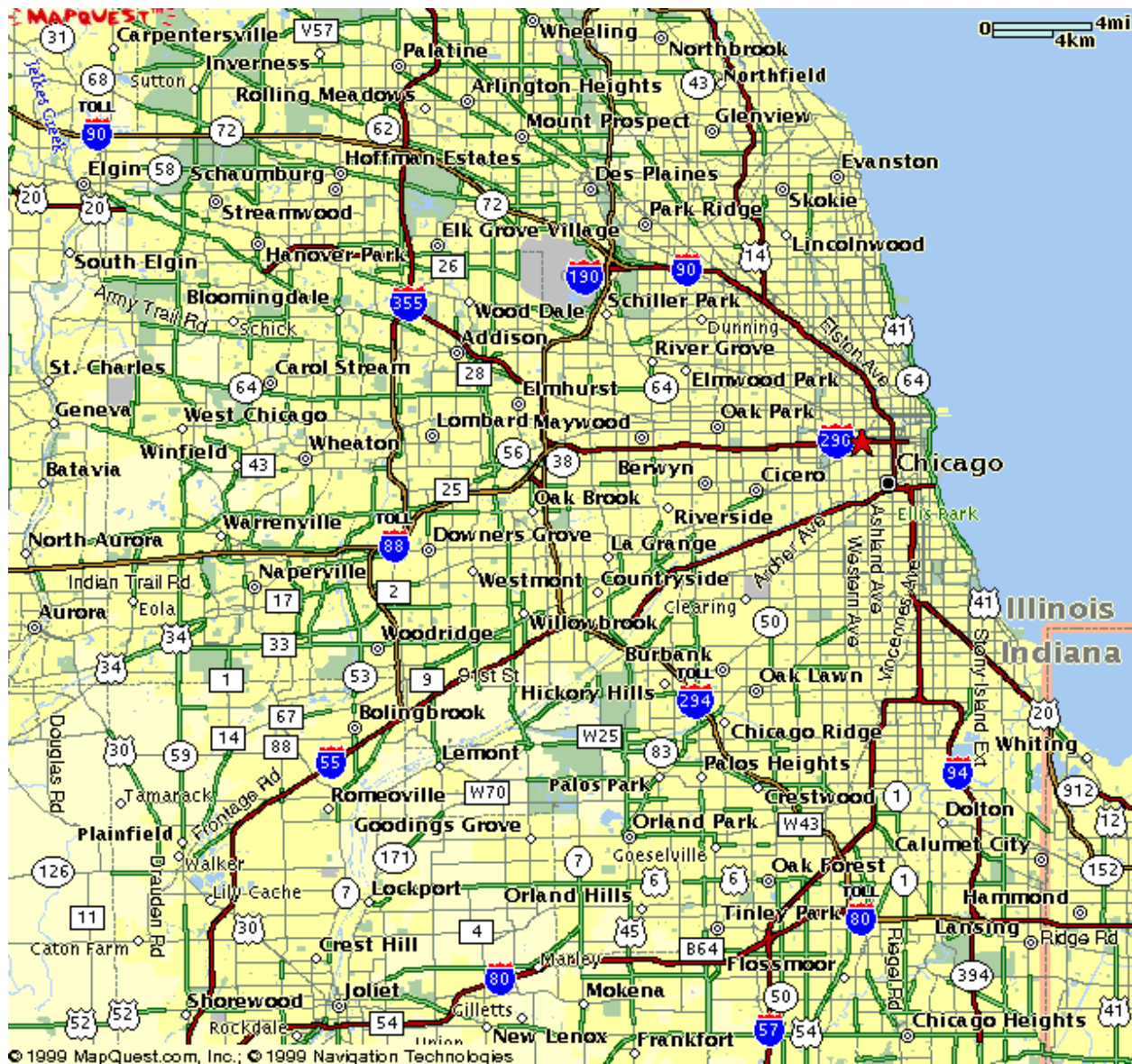


How to drive to Rush Presbyterian St. Luke's Medical Center

1750 West Harrison, Chicago, IL 60612



If you are coming in on I-80 or the Chicago Skyway you take I-90/94 North to I-290 West (the Eisenhower Expressway, toward "Western Suburbs") for 1-2 miles. After the incredibly nasty merge take the second exit - Paulina/Ashland (Medical Center), which will come up pretty quickly. Turn left (south) on Ashland. You will cross over the Eisenhower Expressway immediately, and go 1 block beyond to Harrison. Immediately on your right is the Medical Center complex. The Rush parking garage is the enormous concrete structure with the Guggenheim-like spiral ramps.

From the parking garage there are two main options (good or bad weather). (1) Go down to the ground floor and walk across the street (to the north side) and west 1 block to the Jelke Bldg. (1750 West Harrison) - the tall one with the ramp from the street to the front door. Take the express elevators to the 12th floor. You made it! (2) You can go to the 4th floor of the parking garage and walk across the street on an enclosed aerial sidewalk. Ask someone where the JELKE building is. Once you get there, take the D elevators (first ones you will encounter) to the 12th floor. If the D elevators don't work that day, follow the other angry people to any other elevators and go to the 12th floor.
